

ICAS Foundation students receive:

A financial bursary of up to £2,500 each year to assist with study costs.

Mentoring from an experienced Chartered Accountant.

Assistance in finding internships and graduate roles.

Eligibility:

All applicants must be UK citizens, or residents with leave to remain.

You must be planning to study an undergraduate course in accountancy or finance at university.

Your parental, guardian or household annual income must be below £34,000.

Have you applied for an accountancy or finance course at university starting in 2021?

If you are planning to study an accountancy or finance course at university from September 2021, you could be eligible to join the ICAS Foundation programme.

The ICAS Foundation supports academically talented young people from less advantaged backgrounds by helping them take their first steps into a professional career in accountancy or finance. Students benefit from a range of support including bursary funding, mentoring assistance and help to access internships.

We are now accepting applications for Autumn 2021 entry – the closing date for submitting your application is Monday 31 May 2021.

We recommend submitting your application early, so that we can review your application and request any additional details which may assist in our assessment.
