- You are a UK taxpayer, and the ICAS Foundation can treat all donations you make to us as Gift Aid donations until you notify us otherwise
- You pay an amount of income tax / capital gains tax at least equal to the amount that we will reclaim on your donation in this tax year (and if you pay less income tax / capital gains tax than the amount of gift aid claimed on all your charitable donations in that tax year, it is your responsibility to pay any difference)
- You understand the ICAS Foundation will reclaim 25p of tax on every £1 you have donated
